All students are expected to know and follow the rules and parents are asked to make sure their children understand this. The school greatly appreciates the support of its parents in this way.

1. Students are expected to behave responsibly and respectfully to each other, their teachers and to members of the public both in and out of the Camp Compass Program.
2. Academy property is to be kept clean and not vandalized or defaced in any way.
3. All personal belongings, including books, must be clearly marked with the student's name. NO PERFUME OR COLONGE!!!
4. All visitors are to report in immediately after entering the academy.
5. Students are expected to be punctual to class and all other Camp Compass activities.
6. Absenteeism - parents/guardians of students who are absent are requested to telephone the academy pager between 3:30 and 5:30 p.m. to inform the staff of their child's absence. (610)778-0576
7. No student can leave the Academy property without permission from the Office Staff and must request the use of bathroom facilities in case of emergencies.
8. Medication, if required, should be taken to a staff member together with a note of explanation from parents or guardians.
9. No valuables are to be carried to Academy. The Academy will not be responsible for loss of valuables or money. Students must not bring to school any form of glass container, any form of audio equipment, or any instrument which could be used as a dangerous weapon.
10. School and Homework – is to be done at the discretion of Academy staff. A lesson will be provided each academy session.
11. Obscenities in any form are not tolerated.
12. Chewing gum or eating of food is not allowed at any time, unless given by Office Staff.
13. No running in the corridors is permitted. Movement around the academy must be quiet and orderly.
14. Formal School detentions/suspensions must be served immediately and Academy staff notified the following Monday or earlier by phone.
15. All litter must be disposed of in the trash bins provided. Students who drop litter anywhere else will be given a disciplinary assignment and/or made to pick up litter as a punishment.
16. **3 unexcused absences or ANY misconduct will result in dismissal from the program.**
